SUBJECT: Alternate National Executive Committee person voting privilege

Whereas: Article V, Section 2 of the Department Constitution states “ The Department Executive Committee shall be comprised of the Department President, Department Vice President, Department Secretary, Department Treasurer, the District Presidents, National Executive Committee person, Alternate National Executive Committee person, Department Parliamentarian, Department Chaplain, Department Historian, Department Sgt. – at- Arms and Department Assistant Sgt.-at-Arms

The Department Secretary, Department Treasurer, Department Parliamentarian, Department Chaplain, Department Historian, Department Sgt. – at- Arms and Department Assistant Sgt.-at-Arms shall be members of the Department Executive Committee, with all rights except the right to vote.”

Whereas: Article VI, Section 5 of the Department Constitution states “It shall be the duty of the Alternate National Executive Committee person to act in the capacity of the National Executive Committee person in their absence or inability to act.

Whereas: The Alternate National Executive Committee person acts in the absence or inability to act of the National Executive Committee person, only one vote is required there for, be it

Be it Resolved: That the Alternate National Executive Committee person does not get a vote of their own. The Alternate National Executive Committee person only votes when acting in place of the National Executive Committee person.
